Overview

RIPS Singapore is a Summer program for talented undergraduate students from NUS, Asia and the U.S. with background in mathematics, statistics, data science, computer science or related areas. Participants work fulltime for nine weeks in international teams on real research problems proposed by our industry partners.

Location

RIPS Singapore will be held at the Institute for Mathematical Sciences (IMS) on NUS campus, where offices for all teams are provided

Benefits

Students from NUS and Asian universities receive a **stipend of S\$3000**. Travel will be covered for international students. In order to foster interaction, all participants, including local students, are provided with accommodation either on campus or hotels near the campus.
